MASTER THESIS Heavy work, strictly framed

Characteristics

- To be done preferably within your specialization, and to consider as a valuable work
- Scientific approach, with sound academic references
- With a real managerial issue

Progression

- Follow your supervisor instructions
- … and get ready for graduation!

MASTER THESIS How to graduate in July

Work is sequenced throughout four delivrables

- You must manage your time with great care
- Do your best to deliver, on time, your best possible deliverables.
- Target the 1st session of graduation (July): *it's possible* (80% success)

Do not count on 2nd session as an alternative

- No handout of deliverables will lead you to failure
- It is not possible to realize a master thesis in a few weeks
- Do not expect assistance from your supervisor during the summer break
- In case of 2nd session failure: <u>retake</u>.

BLENDED LEARNING (Delivery modes)

Class-contact / distance learning / student work

- Class-contact time / Le temps présentiel (PR) :
 - Usual, in class, whenever the situation permits (shall replace a **DS**).
- Distance learning time / Le temps distanciel :
 - <u>Synchronous</u> (**DS**) : video-conference
 - Asynchronous (**DA**) : based on resources on MyICN (videos, readings, ...)
- Student work / Le temps du travail personnel (TE) :
 - Sometimes included as a session, but more often, to be achieved in addition to sessions.
 - For preliminary & further readings, exercises, projects, ...



PROJECT MODE (Types of times)

30 h = 21 h « course » + 9h « project »

• The course :

- Lecture / cours classique (CM)
- Directed work / travaux dirigés (TD)
- The project :
 - Student work / Travail étudiant (TE) : with a precise time slot, or at your convenience.
 - Scheduled assistance / Accompagnement planifié (AP) : with a precise time slot, with your instructor (project work + support from your instructor).
 - Unscheduled assistance / Accompagnement non planifié (AN) : without a precise time slot, with your instructor (forum, office hours, rendez-vous, ... to solve various problems).
