Context and objective

Graduate as soon as possible

- **QUITUS** are mandatory graduating conditions.
- Rules can be found on the **Programme Regulations**
 - **Note** : they are also presented each year, during the welcoming meeting in September
(see MyICN for prog. Regulations, and kick-off meeting slides)
- Some quitus are related to **legal constraints** (French University master level) – LV1 & Int'l
- Failure to obtain a quitus **systematically results in delayed graduation**

→ It is very important to anticipate, and make sure everything is / will be OK to graduate ASAP after PGE3

Attention points

- Rules are clear: do not interpret them, and never suppose what the assessment board may decide
 - Rules may change: programme regulations is your unique reference (*not alumni!*)
 - Dispensation requests:
 - All requests must relate solely to the situations listed (see: “dispensation request procedures” on MyICN)
 - All requests must be justified, submitted to the registrar, and documented
 - Do not count on dispensations; rejections are many
- It's your duty to **verify that everything is ready for graduation**
- Please check the **General Procedures** published on MyICN

Quitus LV1

External English certification

Required minimum score:

- **TOEIC** : 750 – 785 (*new PGE1 students in 24-25*)
- **TOEFL** : 78 – 88 (*new PGE1 students in 24-25*)
- **GMAT** : 550

Automatic exemptions:

- Native speakers (English = mother tongue)

Quitus LV1

Dispensation request

Accepted mitigating circumstances must be:

- An official score very close to the minimum (TOEIC, or others)
 - If so, enough time spent on GlobalExam (proof of serious and continuous preparation)



There is no guarantee that the assessment board will grant the exemption.

GlobalExam tests and other Covid-19-specific provisions are not valid anymore to automatically obtain the LV1 Quitus

International Quitus

One semester abroad

Required experience:

- **Academic stay** in partner university (a least one semester)
- **Professional experience abroad**, including Switzerland, Belgium, Luxembourg, ...
 - *Whatever the contract type (CDD, VIE, internship, ...) / minimum 5 months*
- **ICN Certificate** in Berlin or Chengdu
- **GICC Certificate** - Global Int'l Competency Certificate

Exemptions:

- Foreign students, either:
 - Coming to study in France in the MiM
 - *Based on foreign passport or ID*
- For AST2 students only, either:
 - Two-year apprenticeship (PGE2+PGE3)
 - Two-year double degree (A/E+PGE3)

International Quitus Dispensation request

Accepted mitigating circumstances must be:

- During MiM: professional experience in France with assignments of a highly international nature carried out abroad for at least 50% of the planned working time
- Before MiM: significant international experience



There is no guarantee that the assessment board will grant the exemption.

Covid-19-specific provisions are not valid anymore to automatically obtain this quitus

Professional Quitus

Validated professional experience

Required professional experience:

- **Minimum of 9 months** (6 months for students entering MiM directly in PGE2: AST2, Lorrain2)
 - Of **approved**, ie prior registered in our system, and mission approved by ICN
 - And **validated**, ie assessed by ICN with deliverables + company appraisal
- **Successful professional experience** during the PGE/MiM course:
 - Internships, apprenticeships, entrepreneurship, CDD, CDI, VIE, job contracts
 - With at least one long experience (>= 5 months) – *In Gap Year and/or PGE3*
 - Final validation in PGE3, based on a “professional portfolio” (*see below*)

Exemptions:

- *None*

Professional Quitus Dispensation request

Accepted mitigating circumstances must be:

- Prior significant professional experience:
 - With missions corresponding to MiM expectations
 - With **strong** evidence, and ICN evaluation
- Student enrolled in two-year double degree



There is no guarantee that the assessment board will grant the exemption

Professional Quitus

Validating rules

For each professional experiences:

- Self assessment
- Synthesis
- Student report **only for the first experience in the PGE/MiM course.**
 - That means: You do not have to write a report for your experience this year, provided you already submitted a report related to a former experience.

→ **Follow the rules** of “Guide des expériences professionnelles PGE” / “Professionnal Experiences Guide PGE” (MyICN)

Professional Quitus Professional Portfolio

To validate the Professional Quitus you will be asked to sum up all your professional experiences realised in the PGE/MiM course in a “**Professional Portfolio**”

- Self assessment, synthesis, and reports of *all* of your experiences are useful
- The portfolio is expected for the PGE3 Seminar, in May
(even if you cannot participate)

→ **Portfolio assessment gives a grade for the Seminar module** (PGE3, Semester 6)

Dispensation Request Warning

- **Must rely** on **listed mitigating circumstances**. Immediate rejection for:
 - « I had no time to... » / « I've got a job now... »
 - « I decided not to... » / « I'd rather... »
 - « I thought that... » / « I've heard that... »
 - Requests without any justification, documents, evidence, ...
- **No assurance** that any dispensation will be granted
- Must be submitted on MyICN **prior** the assessment board meeting
- Must be carefully ***justified and documented***: **requires evidences**

Dispensation Request Procedure

- All requests for dispensation must be submitted as a ZIP or PDF file, and uploaded on Myicn. **No request by email!**

Le règlement d'examens est le document de référence sur lequel le jury s'appuie. Il est donc important que vous en preniez connaissance pour connaître toutes les exigences du Programme et les conditions nécessaires pour obtenir votre diplôme le plus rapidement possible.

The "règlement d'examens" contains general regulations for the PGE (master in management), used by the assessment board. It is important that you read carefully this document, in order to understand program requirements, so that you can graduate as soon as possible.

The "règlement d'examens" consists in several documents:

1. Le règlement pédagogique qui décrit les règles générales s'appliquant au PGE / Diplôme ICN Grande Ecole.
Course regulations describe general regulations applicable to the PGE / Master in Management
2. Les **procédures générales** de validation des différents séjours académiques, professionnels et internationaux et de votre mémoire de fin d'études, qui indiquent, notamment, les dates limites de rendu et soutenance.
General procedures explain how to validate our Professional, International, and Foreign Language 1 (English) quitus, and the master thesis. It also gives some important deadlines.
3. Les exigences liées à la validation des Quitus International et Professionnel en fonction de votre cursus à l'Ecole.
Quitus validation rules give more information about Quitus validation, depending on your specific situation.
