

Log in

If a Microsoft account other than ICN-ARTEM.COM is registered on your computer, you will have to open EDUSIGN in private browsing mode.




Click on your next course

With Edusign, 2 attendance tracking methods are offered to you:



This is the default attendance method that every instructor must use. It is the most secure method of attendance.

- Very small classes (if the QR code is inconvenient)



This is the default attendance method that every instructor must use. It is the most secure method of attendance.



Click on this tab to directly display the QR code.

Show the QR code to the students

They can scan it with their Edusign app to mark their attendance in class.



Display a smaller version of the QR code

This will allow you to conduct your class while letting students scan the QR code at the same time.

Exemple:

Click this button to display a smaller version of the QR code over your screen.




A learner cannot sign with their phone.



Check that students have signed


Signatures will appear in real time on your platform.



Students will receive an email, and the signature will appear in real time: no confirmation is required from you. Your administration will also receive the information in real time.




1. Select the students present

Send an individual signature email


If your organization has not authorized the sending of multiple signature emails, you can still send individual emails to each student present.
