Admission Tracks

According to French law & regulations:

All admissions at ICN must comply with a competitive exam

French ICN students

"Concours" \rightarrow ICN1 / ICN2 \rightarrow ICN3

Foreign students

IPM2 (= ICN2 !) \rightarrow "AST" Competitive Exam \rightarrow ICN3





Competitive exam

<u>For IPM students only</u>, according to our rules, entering the PGE requires a twofold competitive exam:

Written part: GMAT + English
Students who validate IPM do not need to take the exams above!

Oral part: English + Motivation An interview in Nürnberg, in May.

Gap year is optional, upon <u>your</u> request, and needs to be approved.

The examinations rules





Fundamentals

A **year**= 60 ECTS credits, that is 2 semesters of 30-credits

An **semester**= a set of Teaching Units (TU)

A TU= a set of teaching modules





Examinations

Each module organizes assessments:

- Continuous assessment, final exam (written or oral), report, participation...
- One single grade is calculated for each module
- Disqualifying grade: 5/20

TU is also assessed by a grade (average of modules grades)

- TU grade >= 10/20: PASS
- TU grade < 10: FAIL</p>

Evaluation documents

ICN1 internship

Report, evaluated in Year 2 (due date: mid October)

Long internship (G/Y or Year 3)

- "Long" = at least 5 months
- Assessment scheme: enterprise + school
- For <u>each</u> experience.

Int'l Academic Semester

University Transcript





Assessment Board

Examines results and decides:

- PASS: go to Year 3
- FAIL: year or semester repeat Retake sometimes difficult!
- DISMISS: no possibility to continue in ICN PGE Programme

Discipline Board

- Regulations break
- Inadequate behavior (school, internship, academic, ...)
- Plagiarism, fraud

Studying in Nürnberg validates your Int'l Quitus

Academic semester abroad is possible

- 150 universities, Double Degrees, MSc IM/MIEX
- Erasmus (European Union)

GREAT opportunities for your Professional & Personal Profile!





ICN Quitus correspond to mandatory activities

All must be validated by the end of Year 3 (before board meets!)

Quitus to validate:

- English: TOEIC, TOEFL or GMAT
- International : done!
- Professional : 9 months
 - Generally: 3 months in 1A / 2A + 6 months during G/Y + 6 months in Year 3





Academic semester(s)

When? G/Y, S5, S6

Caution: in case of an academic stay during a gap year:

No Erasmus scholarship in Europe.

ECTS credits cannot be taken into account.

Professionnal quitus

General case: 9 months total, including a long experience.

Specific cases: see MyICN

Professional experience:

Can be done under an internship agreement, or any other contract (CDD, CDI, VIE, ...)

The mission must be validated by your tutor.





Internships and gap year

The gap year is optional. It does not « count » You must apply for a gap year

You can do whatever you want during a gap year...

BUT: <u>internships</u> are restricted:

- OK, if linked to Year 2 (M1), ie begins before Aug. 31st of M1.
- OK, if an academic semester is planned (requires 200 hours of class contact)
- Consequently, two internships are not allowed
- Any other form of contract is OK



Internship Regulations







Professional experience assessment

EACH experience must be assessed separately

Evaluated by School + enterprise

For each experience

- Only a self assessment, plus a synthesis
- Collect information (5 notes recommended)
- At the end of the programme: one single big report ("portfolio").

Prof'l Quitus validation

• At the end of the programme, after examination of <u>all</u> internships.

Long experience (G/Y or Year 3)

One single guide

Academic Semester

Depends on the P.U. regulatory rules

Master's Thesis

• One guide & related documents (*new e-Learning platform*)





Master's thesis

Think about it <u>asap</u>!

- Work *in tandem*
- Preparatory readings
- Experiences to exploit (G/Y)
- Precise Requirements

- <u>Always</u> a last minute problem !!
